**Art 2.3: now reads:**

Should an event be cancelled or excluded for any reason and the reserve event is not run, **or if the cancellation or exclusion of one of the events is announced after 15 November 2013**, the number of events to count towards each competitor's final score will be reduced by one.

**Art 4.3: now reads:**

A competitor winning an event outright (**i.e. where no other competitor on same penalties**) will be awarded one extra point.

**Art 6.4: NOVICE - now reads:**

Any competitor, other than a Beginner, who has not navigated before **01.09.09** plus any competitor who has not been promoted.

**Art 7.2: now reads:**

The resolution of ties in an individual event for the purpose of allocating championship points will be decided on the following principles:

**7.2.1 The lesser experienced crew (beginner beats novice beats semi-expert beats expert).**

**7.2.2 Furthest cleanest.**
