4 REGISTRATION PROCESS

4.1 Procedure

Registration must be made online at fiarallystar.com.

The registration of a candidate implies full and complete acceptance of the FIA Rally Star Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

The fastest 60 (the top 10 from Challenges 7-15) Irish candidates competing in the #RallyAtHome Challenge will be invited to the Digital Challenge National Final.

4.2 Number of candidates accepted

The maximum number of candidates accepted will be 60.

4.3 Number of participations per candidate

Each Candidate has the opportunity to participate in a maximum of two Digital Challenges organised by the same ASN. Motorsport Ireland will only be holding one Digital Challenge.

4.4 Eligibility Criteria for Candidates

Nationality	To be eligible, a candidate must hold a valid Irish passport and be resident on the island of Ireland.
Age	On January 1 st of the year in which this Digital Challenge takes place, candidates must be at least 17 and at most 26 years old. A parental authorization signed by the legal representative(s) will be requested from minors.
Driving licence	A driver's license is not required to participate in the Digital Challenge.
Competition licence	Restrictions on those who hold competition licences issued by Motorsport Ireland will apply as per 4.5.2 of the FIA Rally Star Sporting Regulations.

In addition to the criteria defined in the FIA Rally Star Sporting Regulations and in these Supplementary Regulations, the FIA and the organising ASN reserve the right to exclude any candidate who does not correspond to the criteria or spirit of the programme.

4.5 Registration fee

Each candidate must pay a registration fee of €10 payable at the latest at the time of the administrative checks at the Digital Challenge National Final.

The authorised means of payment are : Credit/debit card, Paypal. Cash will be accepted but contactless payment methods are preferred.

All expenses of the candidates associated with the Digital Challenge (travel, meals, accommodation, etc.) will not be covered by Motorsport Ireland or the FIA.

4.6 Registration fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full

- if the event does not take place
- to candidates whose entry application is rejected

In the event of no-show of the candidate, the registration fee shall be retained by Motorsport Ireland, except in cases of force majeure (on presentation of supporting documents).

4.7 Confirmation of registration

After validation of the registration process on the fiarallystar.com website, a convocation is issued to each candidate.

This contains the candidate number, a summary of the data provided, the place, date and time of convocation. The candidate must download his invitation. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that he has the convocation.

4.8 Administrative Checks

Candidates must prepare and submit the following documents to the administrative checks:

- Convocation
- Proof of payment (for payment by bank transfer or credit card) or payment (cash or bank cheque)
- Identity document
- Competition licence (if any)
- Signed consent form
- Signed parental consent (for minors)
- Verification of #RallyAtHome Challenge qualifying time

Candidates must respect the time indicated on the convocation, otherwise their participation may be refused.

5 INSURANCE

The event will be covered under the insurance policy of Auto Simulation Ltd t/a digital-motorsports.com.

6 SELECTION PROCESS

The full selection process is set in the FIA Rally Star Sporting Regulations.

7 SAFETY

Candidates are required to observe at all times the safety rules and instructions of the organisation team. Any candidate who does not respect the safety rules may be excluded from the Digital Challenge, without refund of entry fees.

8 CLASSIFICATIONS AND PRIZES

The classification of the Digital Challenge will be determined on the basis of the best time for each Candidate, set with the FIA Rally Star simulator.

The winning candidates will become eligible for the FIA Rally Star Continental Final of Europe.

9 DISPUTES

Disputes arising during the Digital Challenge will be handled by the Clerk of the Course. If necessary, the Clerk of the Course may appeal to the arbitration of the FIA Rally Star Committee.
